

Today, people with power who don't take their work and responsibilities seriously are toying with the destiny of the people. Their arrogance and mockery are felt by the working classes, but to what end? Ubu Without Horns warns us of an ever increasing and dangerous reality, of a powerful enemy corroding the foundations of humanity.
